WEARING THE MASK

Variable regulations depending on the municipality/city

COMPULSORY IN BRUSSELS

Curfew: from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Close contacts: 1 person

Restaurants and bars are closed.
Takeaway until 10 p.m.

Private gatherings:
maximum 4 people

Selling alcohol is forbidden after 8 p.m.

Amusement parks are closed

Teleworking is the rule that must be applied strictly

Flea markets, bric-a-brac markets and Christmas markets are forbidden

Higher education: distance-learning courses are generalised

Secondary education

From Wednesday 28 October, all schools must organise distance-learning courses

INQUIRE REGULARLY GIVEN THAT THE MEASURES EVOLVE ACCORDING TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE EPIDEMIC

BRUSSELS

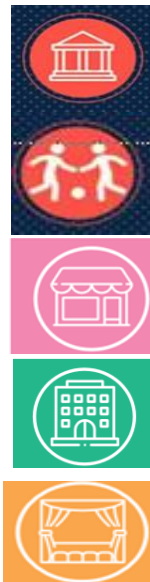
Cultural sites are closed

Sports facilities (swimming pool, fitness...) are closed

In the shops: 1 person maximum
(children not included)

Rest home :
2 visitors per resident - always the same for 15 days

Weddings and funerals
Funeral ceremonies: maximum 15 people allowed, respecting the distance of 1.5m;
Weddings: only in the presence of the spouses, their witnesses and the civil registry officer (civil marriage) or minister of religion (religious marriage)



WALLONIA

Cultural sites are open, health measures are reinforced. 40 to 200 people allowed depending on safety conditions, physical distance and the decision of the local authorities

Indoor sports are forbidden except for the children aged under 12 years old

In the shops: 2 people maximum
(children not included)

Rest home:
1 visitor per resident- always the same for 15 days

Weddings and funerals:
A maximum of 40 people are allowed, respecting social distancing. Wearing a mask is compulsory. No reception or banquet can be organised after the ceremony
