<p><b>EDUCATION</b></p> <p>Primary education 1<sup>st</sup> stage of secondary education: at school 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> stage of secondary education: 50% at school &amp; exams in person Higher education: physical presence on campus 1 day per week and exams in person Primary and secondary education: 1 day extracurricular activities Outdoors The consultative committee will evaluate at the end of April whether full-time face-to-face secondary education is possible from the beginning of May</p> <p>Change to upward trends: distance learning after 1 infection</p>	<p><b>END OF THE EASTER PAUSE</b></p> <p>Shops open without an appointment, shopping with one other person from the same household</p> <p>Non-medical close-contact professions can reopen</p> <p><b>MORE NUMEROUS OUTSIDE</b></p> <p>Meetings outdoors in groups of 10 people max.</p> <p><b>PILOT PROJECTS</b></p> <p>Pilot projects in various sectors, including culture, events and sports</p>	<p><b>"OUTDOOR" PLAN</b></p> <p>End of the curfew Between midnight and 5am: up to 3 people outdoors (people who are not from the same household) Or members of the same household</p> <p>Outdoors organised activities: 25 people max.</p> <p>Sport without an audience</p> <p>Restaurants and pubs: outside terraces</p> <p>Events, receptions and banquets, cultural performances and worship services: Up to 50 people outdoors</p> <p>Flea markets and bric-a-brac markets</p> <p><b>CLOSE CONTACTS</b></p> <p>Inside with two close contacts of the household</p> <p><b>CHILDREN &amp; YOUNG PEOPLE</b></p> <p>Organised activities: 25 people max. outdoors (up to and including 18 years old) and 10 people max. indoors (up to and including 12 years old) Provided that the situation in the intensive care units has improved permanently</p>	<p><b>MORE ACTIVITIES OUTDOORS</b></p> <p>Culture &amp; events</p> <p>Annual markets &amp; fairs</p> <p>Rules for the summer camps</p> <p><b>"INDOOR" PLAN</b></p> <p>More social contacts</p> <p>Restaurants and pubs</p> <p>Events, cultural performances and worship services</p> <p>Sport and fitness</p> <p>Opportunities to return to companies, associations and services</p> <p>Provided that the situation in the intensive care units is normalized</p>
